The stitches and abbreviations are as follows:

sl st = slip stitch

ch = chain

dc = single crochet

htr = half-double crochet

tr = double crochet

dtr = treble crochet

bpdc = back post single crochet

bphtr = back post half-double crochet

bptr = back post double crochet

fphtr = front post half-double crochet

fptr = front post double crochet

fpdtr = front post treble crochet

dtr2tog = work treble crochet decrease across two stitches

fphtr2tog = work front post half-double crochet decrease across two stitches

fptr2tog = work front post double crochet decrease across two stitches

fpdtr2tog = work front post treble crochet decrease across two stitches

fpdtr3tog = work front post treble crochet decrease across three stitches or as specified.

V stitch = (tr, ch2, tr) in same stitch

Narrow V stitch = (tr, ch1, tr) in same stitch

Cluster = worked with three tr stitches throughout pattern.

Shell stitch= (tr, ch1, tr, ch1, tr, ch1, tr) in same stitch.

Rectangle section

Notes: This is worked up with alternating rows of double crochet + post stitches, and single crochet. You turn the piece at the end of each row. The single crochet is worked with the back side of the piece facing, the double crochet + post stitches are worked with the front side facing. You may find it helpful to use stitch markers to mark where you put the post stitches.

You need to make four of these rectangles.

- 1) With camel, work 65 foundation double crochet.
- 2) Turn, ch1. Dc in same stitch, then dc in next 64 stitches. Break off yarn. Turn.
- 3) With sage, begin with standing tr in first dc of row.

Tr in next 3 stitches, then fpdtr around fifth foundation tr from row 1. Skip st behind fpdtr.

Tr in next 9 stitches, then fpdtr around 15th foundation tr from row 1. Skip st behind fpdtr.

Tr in next 9 stitches, then fpdtr around 25th foundation tr from row 1. Skip st behind fpdtr.

Tr in next 7 stitches, then fpdtr around 33rd foundation tr from row 1. Skip st behind fpdtr.



Tr in next 7 stitches, then fpdtr around 41st foundation tr from row 1. Skip st behind fpdtr. Tr in next 9 stitches, then fpdtr around 51st foundation tr from row 1. Skip st behind fpdtr. Tr in next 9 stitches, then fpdtr around 61st foundation tr from row 1. Skip st behind fpdtr. Tr in next 4 stitches. (7 fpdtr, 58 tr).

4) Turn, ch1. Dc in same stitch, then dc in next 64 stitches. Break off yarn. Turn.

5) With saffron, begin with standing tr in first dc of row.


Tr in next 3 stitches, then fpdtr around fpdtr from row 3. Skip st behind fpdtr.

Tr in next 9 stitches, then fpdtr around fpdtr from row 3. Skip st behind fpdtr.

Tr in next 9 stitches, then fpdtr around fpdtr from row 3. Skip st behind fpdtr.

Tr in next 6 stitches. fpdtr around fpdtr from row 3, skip next stitch, tr in next stitch, fpdtr around the same fpdtr from row 3, skip next stitch. (Photo 2)

Tr in next 6 stitches, then fpdtr around fpdtr from row 3. Skip st behind fpdtr.



Tr in next 9 stitches, then fpdtr around fpdtr from row 3. Skip st behind fpdtr.

Tr in next 4 stitches. (8 fpdtr, 57 tr)



- 6) Turn, ch1. Dc in same stitch, then dc in next 64 stitches. Break off yarn. Turn.
- 7) With gold, begin with standing tr in first dc of row.

Tr in next 2 stitches. Fpdtr around fpdtr from row 5, skip next stitch, tr in next stitch, fpdtr around same fpdtr, skip next stitch. (Photo 2)

Tr in next 8 stitches, then fpdtr around fpdtr from row 5. Skip st behind fpdtr.

Tr in next 9 stitches, then fpdtr around fpdtr from row 5. Skip st behind fpdtr.

Tr in next 7 stitches, then fpdtr3tog around tr from row 5, (between the two fpdtr from row 5, Photo 3). Skip st behind fpdtr3tog Tr in next 7 stitches. Fpdtr around fpdtr from row 3, Skip st behind fpdtr



Tr in next 8 stitches. Fpdtr around fpdtr from row 5, skip next stitch, tr in next stitch, fpdtr around same fpdtr, skip next stitch. (Photo 2)

Tr in next 8 stitches, fpdtr around fpdtr from row 5, Skip st behind fpdtr Tr in next four stitches. (8 fpdtr, 1 fpdtr3tog, 56 tr)

8) Turn, ch1. Dc in same stitch, then dc in next 64 stitches. Break off yarn. Turn.

9) With claret, begin with standing tr in first dc of row.

Tr in next 3 stitches, then fpdtr3tog around tr of row 7 (between two fpdtr, Photo 3). Skip st behind fpdtr3tog.

Tr in next 8 stitches. Fpdtr around fpdtr from row 7, skip next stitch, tr in next stitch, fpdtr around same fpdtr from row 7, then skip next stitch (Photo 2).

Tr in next 8 stitches, then fpdtr around fpdtr from row 7. Skip st behind fpdtr

Tr in next 14 stitches. Fpdtr around fpdtr from row 7, skip next stitch, tr in next stitch, fpdtr around same fpdtr from row 7, skip next stitch (Photo 2).

Tr in next 8 stitches, then fpdtr3tog around tr from row 7 (between two fpdtr Photo 3). Skip st behind fpdtr3tog.

Tr in next 8 stitches. Fpdtr around fpdtr from row 7, skip next stitch, tr in next stitch, fpdtr around same fpdtr from row 7, skip next stitch (Photo 2).

Tr in next 3 stitches. (2 fpdtr3tog, 7 fpdtr, 56 tr)

- 10) Turn, ch1. Dc in same stitch, then dc in next 64 stitches. Break off yarn. Turn.
- 11) With citron, begin with standing tr in first dc of row.

Tr in next 13 stitches. Fpdtr3tog around 13th tr from row nine (between two fpdtr, Photo 3), Skip st behind fpdtr3tog.

Tr in next 8 stitches. Fpdtr around fpdtr from row 9, skip next stitch, tr in next stitch, fpdtr around same fpdtr from row 9, skip next stitch.(Photo 2)

Tr in next 14 stitches, then fpdtr3tog around tr from row 9 (between two fpdtr Photo 3). Skip st behind fpdtr3tog.

Tr in next 19 stitches. Fpdtr3tog in tr of row 9 (between two fpdtr, Photo 3). Skip st behind fpdtr3tog

Tr in next 4 stitches. (3 fpdtr3tog, 2 fpdtr, 60tr)

- 12) Turn, ch1. Dc in same stitch, then dc in next 64 stitches. Break off yarn. Turn.
- 13) With copper, begin with standing tr in first dc of row.

Tr in next 23 stitches. Fpdtr3tog around tr from row 11. Skip st behind fpdtr3tog

Tr in next 7 stitches, then fpdtr around 30th tr from row 11(33rd stitch of row). **This should be in the centre of your row**. Tr in next 32 stitches. (1 fpdtr3tog, 1 fpdtr, 63 tr)



14) Turn, ch1. Dc in same stitch, then dc in next 64 stitches. Break off yarn. Turn.

15) With stone, begin with standing tr in first dc of row.

Tr in next 3 stitches. Fpdtr around fifth tr of row 13. Skip st behind fpdtr

Tr in next 27 stitches, then fpdtr around fpdtr from row 13. Skip st behind fpdtr

Tr in next 17 stitches. Fpdtr around 49th tr of row 13 (51st stitch of row). Skip st behind fpdtr.

Tr in next 14 stitches. (3 fpdtr, 62 tr)

16) Turn, ch1. Dc in same stitch, then dc in next 64 stitches. Break off yarn. Turn.



17) With meadow, begin with standing tr in first dc of row.

Tr in next 3 stitches, then fpdtr around fpdtr from row 15. Skip st behind fpdtr.

Tr in next 9 stitches. Fpdtr around 14th tr of row 15. (15th stitch of row) Skip st behind fpdtr

Tr in next 17 stitches, then fpdtr around fpdtr from row 15. Skip st behind fpdtr.

Tr in next 7 stitches. Fpdtr around 39th tr of row 15. (41st stitch of row) Skip st behind fpdtr

Tr in next 9 stitches, then fpdtr around fpdtr from row 15. Skip st behind fpdtr.

Tr in next 9 stitches. Fpdtr around 58th tr of row 15(61st stitch of row).. Skip st behind fpdtr.

Tr in next four stitches. (5 fpdtr, 60 tr).

- 18) Turn, ch1. Dc in same stitch, then dc in next 64 stitches. Break off yarn. Turn.
- 19) With saffron, begin with standing tr in first dc of row.

Tr in next 2 stitches. Fpdtr around fpdtr from row 17, skip next stitch, tr in next stitch, fpdtr around same fpdtr, and skip next stitch. (Photo 2)

Tr in next 8 stitches, then fpdtr around fpdtr from row 17. Skip st behind fpdtr

Tr in next 9 stitches. Fpdtr around 23rd tr of row 17. (25th stitch of row) Skip st behind fpdtr Tr in next 6 stitches. Fpdtr around fpdtr from row 17, skip next stitch, tr in next stitch, fpdtr around same fpdtr, then skip next stitch.(Photo 2)

Tr in next 6 stitches, then fpdtr around fpdtr from row 17. Skip st behind fpdtr

Tr in next 8 stitches. Fpdtr around fpdtr from row 17, skip next stitch, tr in next stitch, fpdtr around same fpdtr, then skip next stitch.(Photo 2)

Tr in next 8 stitches, then fpdtr around fpdtr from row 17. Skip st behind fpdtr

Tr in next 4 stitches. (10 fpdtr, 55 tr)

- 20) Turn, ch1. Dc in same stitch, then dc in next 64 stitches. Break off yarn. Turn.
- 21) With raspberry, begin with standing tr in first dc of row.

Tr in next 3 stitches, then fpdtr3tog around fourth tr of row 19 (between two fpdtr, Photo 3.) Skip st behind fpdtr3tog.

Tr in next 9 stitches, fpdtr around fpdtr from row 19. Skip st behind fpdtr

Tr in next 8 stitches. Fpdtr around fpdtr from row 19, skip next stitch, tr in next stitch, fpdtr

around same fpdtr, and skip next stitch. (Photo2)

Tr in next 6 stitches. Fpdtr3tog around tr of row 19 (between two fpdtr, Photo 3). Skip st behind fpdtr3tog

Tr in next 7 stitches, fpdtr around fpdtr from row 19, Skip st behind fpdtr

Tr in next 9 stitches. Fpdtr3tog around tr from row 19 (between two fpdtr Photo 3). Skip st behind fpdtr3tog

Tr in next 8 stitches. Fpdtr around fpdtr from row 19, skip next stitch, tr in next stitch, fpdtr around same fpdtr, and skip next stitch.(Photo2)

Tr in next 3 stitches. (3 fpdtr3tog, 6 fpdtr, 56 tr)

- 22) Turn, ch1. Dc in same stitch, then dc in next 64 stitches. Break off yarn. Turn.
- 23) With camel, begin with standing tr in first dc of row.

Tr in next 12 stitches. Fpdtr around fpdtr from row 21, skip next stitch, tr in next stitch, fpdtr around same fpdtr, and skip next stitch (Photo 2).

Tr in next 8 stitches, then fpdtr3tog around tr of row 21 (between two fpdtr, Photo 3). Skip st behind fpdtr3tog

Tr in next 14 stitches. Fpdtr around fpdtr from row 21, skip next stitch, tr in next stitch, fpdtr around same fpdtr, and then skip next stitch. (Photo2)

Tr in next 18 stitches. Fpdtr3tog around tr of row 21 (between two fpdtr Photo3). Skip st behind fpdtr3tog

Tr in next four stitches. (4 fpdtr, 2 fpdtr3tog, 50 tr)

- 24) Turn, ch1. Dc in same stitch, then dc in next 64 stitches. Break off yarn. Turn.
- 25) With gold, begin with standing tr in first dc of row.

Tr in next 13 stitches, then fpdtr3tog around tr of row 23 (between two fpdtr Photo3)). Skip st behind fpdtr3tog

Tr in next 25 stitches, then fpdtr3tog around tr of row 23 (between two fpdtr Photo3). Skip st behind fpdtr3tog

Tr in next 24 stitches. (2 fpdtr3tog, 63 tr).

26) Turn, ch1. Dc in same stitch, then dc in next 64 stitches. Break off yarn.

Sew in all ends.
